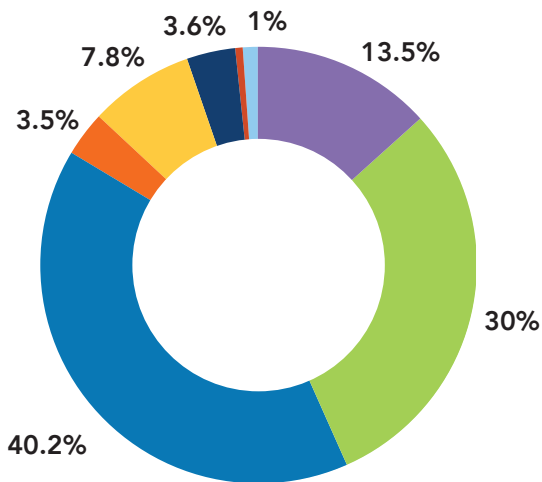


Kaiser Permanente of the Mid-Atlantic States (KPMAS)
